### **Parking & Directions to Seminar Room:**

- Identify how the transition to Managed Care and Community HealthChoices will impact Medicaid rates, level of care appeals, and other financial considerations.
- Assess the impact of new developments in Health Care Law and Regulations on facility status and resources.
- Understand how to maximize reimbursement from all payer sources in the new Managed Care system.
- Describe what the new PA Medical Marijuana Law requires licensed nursing facilities to do to accommodate residents' authorized use of medical marijuana, while protecting Federal licensure/certification and reimbursement.
- Evaluate the impact of recent NLRB Decisions on facility workplace organization status.
- Understand labor law developments, including medical marijuana in PA, which may require an update of employee manuals.
- Identify ways to utilize telemedicine as a way to improve care.
- Describe the ethical considerations involved in dealing with Government Officers and facility attorneys during investigations of facilities.
